- 1.) The '.xml' file will download in a compressed Zip file format.
 - a. If you're going to be emailing the Green Button Data file, email it the Zip file format to keep the size compressed.
 - b. To extract the '.xml' file from the Zip folder > save the Zip file to your desktop, then right-mouse-click on the Zip file to 'Extract'.
 - c. The extracted '.xml' file is generally named something like: "pge_electric_interval_data_1371354911_2016-12-05_to_2017-01-05"
