



PG&E – Green Button Data, download instructions


- 1.) Go to the PG&E website: www.pge.com
- 2.) Sign in using User ID & Password
 - a. If you do not already have an online account, you need to register using your account number.



- 3.) Click on the 'My Usage' hyperlink in the middle column.



4.) Click on the 'Green Button – Download My Data' icon, in the bottom-right.



1.) 'Export your data' screen > choose '.xml' file type & 'export usage for a range of days' > set the date range to the most recent 365 days. **Note: DO NOT choose the 'export all bill totals' option, as that will download monthly billing data, not interval data.**

- 1.) The '.xml' file will download in a compressed Zip file format.
 - a. If you're going to be emailing the Green Button Data file, email it the Zip file format to keep the size compressed.
 - b. To extract the '.xml' file from the Zip folder > save the Zip file to your desktop, then right-mouse-click on the Zip file to 'Extract'.
 - c. The extracted '.xml' file is generally named something like:
"pge_electric_interval_data_1371354911_2016-12-05_to_2017-01-05"
